BEFORE AGM	Jubilee room will be available to us from midday so that we can meet and socialise a bit before we start. The club including toilets and showers is open from 09.30.
AFTER AGM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For Regatta participating Skippers and Crews - Complimentary Supper • For JRA members not entering the Regatta - they can have a meal too (cost TBC shortly). Book a meal in advance with Linda.
FOOD	<p><u>Dinner</u> Saturday - 19:30 For participating Skippers and Crews the YC will offer a Complimentary Fish Supper. Good vegetarian food is available too, it needs to be ordered in advance with Penny.</p> <p><u>Lunch</u> Saturday: If we are ordering a group lunch we can book ahead for meals / food from about £3.50. Monday: If we are to sail on the Monday then it may be possible to arrange food at the club.</p> <p>Linda will coordinate group Lunches (if needed) with the BYC.</p>
WATER SHUTTLE	A water shuttle will run from the Town Pontoon to the Yacht Club on Saturday (4 - 7pm) and Sunday (See the program for details). VHF Channel M1 (37a).
BYC FACILITIES	<p>The BYC and hence the toilets, showers and Jubilee Room are open from 09.30. The BYC will be quite busy during Saturday & Sunday.</p> <p>No dogs allowed in the club.</p>

TRANSPORT	<p>By boat (!), train (to nearby Paignton), coach or drive to Brixham (limited parking).</p> <p>Paignton Train Station Taxi from rank outside station to Brixham or No 12 Stagecoach bus to Brixham every 10 minutes. (Not the returning bus to Newton Abbot!) A C C O M M O D A T I O N	<p>Google search for the type of accommodation required. There is everything from camping to the Berry Head Hotel that was once the home of Rev. Henry Francis Lyte, who wrote the hymn “Abide with me”. Penny will be able to advise on this.</p> <p>Dog friendly accommodation - Google search for this.</p>
ANCHORING MOORING MARINA	<p>There is a free yacht anchorage just outside Brixham outer harbour with one or more free eco-moorings. The yacht club has a slipway, steps and two moored pontoons (no shore access).</p> <p>Brixham Harbour office provides free mooring to their shore access town pontoon to entrants in the Heritage Sailing Regatta.</p> <p>In the past two years some participating crews stayed on their moorings in the outer harbour and used their own dinghies to visit the YC and pick up crew and visit other boats.</p> <p>In extremis there is the marina which is inside Brixham harbour sheltered by the breakwater and a wave fence.</p> <p>In extreme extremis then Dartmouth about 10 miles away by sea is sheltered especially further up the river. It is a 15 minute bus ride from Kingswear (Dartmouth) to Brixham. If it gets that bad then one would expect the regatta to be cancelled.</p>

Anchorage (Free)	<p>Approximately 50°24'16N, 3°31'07W north west of Brixham outer harbour, off Fishcombe and Churston Coves. (approximate depths of 6 to 7 metres mlws).</p> <p>Beware of Lobster pots, and note the route the ferries and fishing boats use in and out of Brixham Port Please do not anchor in seagrass beds. These are inside the 5 knot marker buoys. See this webpage: https://www.livingcoasts.org.uk/conservation/conservation-projects/fishcombe-eco-mooring.</p> <p>Your charts will show you the position of anchorages for commercial shipping in Torbay. http://www.tor-bay-harbour.co.uk/media/1017/seagrass-map.pdf</p>
